

PHI THETA KAPPA LICENSE PLATES!

Greetings Beta Gamma Epsilon,

As you may or may not know, The Ohio Phi Theta Kappa specialty license plate has gone on sale as of June 8, 2015. The license plate costs \$35.00 more than your regular set of plates and \$25.00 of that money goes to the Ohio Region "Commit to Complete Scholarship." To get your plate, I have listed the information below:

The plate can be purchased for any private vehicle excluding motorcycles. If you wish to purchase the plate, all you have to do is o to your local BVM. This can be done at the time of your birthday or sooner if you do not want to wait. To get the plate mid-year, just tell the BMV that you desire the Phi Theta Kappa plate and they will assist you. You will have to pay the additional \$35.00 plus a \$15.00 one-time fee to get a new set of plates. The \$15.00 is the normal fee anytime you want to replace an old set. You will then receive a temporary tag until your new plates come in the mail; about a week. If you wish to buy the plate online at the time of your birthday (not trading in) go to www.oplates.com and follow these instructions:

Click on special plate availability

Check passenger car and hit "continue"

Scroll down until you see the Phi Theta Kappa plate and select it

Click "continue"

Select the option from the specialty plate availability (stock plate number or specialty) and hit "continue"

Finish the check-out procedure

Enjoy your new Phi Theta Kappa license plates!

Congratulations Taylor White!

Dear President Jones,

Congratulations! Your student, Taylor White, has been selected as a **2016 Coca-Cola Leaders of Promise Scholar**. This scholarship is designed to provide new Phi Theta Kappa members with financial resources to help defray educational expenses while enrolled in a two-year college while also encouraging participation in Society programs. This year's recipients were selected by a panel of independent judges from more than 1,100 applicants. Coca-Cola Leaders of Promise Scholars are selected based on outstanding academic achievement and demonstrated leadership potential.

The Leaders of Promise Scholarship is sponsored by the Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation. This Program awards 200 scholars with scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each, totaling \$200,000. Twenty-five of the additional scholarships, a total of \$25,000, are earmarked for Society members who are active personnel or veterans of the U.S. Military. J. Mark Davis, President of the Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation, said their organization feels strongly about supporting engaged community college students, and active-duty service members and veterans in their educational quest.

Disbursements will be made once the student accepts the award and provides supporting documentation to our office. Your student has received a letter and an email with details of the award. A press release will be available in the coming weeks to share with your college public relations department.

The Leaders of Promise Scholarship Program was conceived by International Officers and launched in 2001. The program is a result of the Society's long-range plan, The Alpha Project, which identified the need for scholarships to new Phi Theta Kappa members to assist in their obtaining an associate degree, while also encouraging participation in Society programs. Today, the Coca-Cola Leaders of Promise Scholarship is more relevant than ever as our organization, colleges and communities are actively encouraging completion of a college credential, an associate degree or certificate, among community college students.

Again, congratulations on your student's outstanding academic achievements and leadership potential that have earned them this prestigious award. Registration begins at 9 a.m. and the walk begins at 10 a.m.


We encourage your participation and support. There will be more information forth-coming for online donations. I will also have donation forms for those who; like me, are "old school!"
